Decision and reasons on application for the determination to be marked in private

The legal assessor reminded the panel that while Rule 19(1) provides, as a starting point, that hearings shall be conducted in public, Rule 19(3) states that the panel may hold hearings partly or wholly in private if it is satisfied that this is justified by the interests of any party or by the public interest.

Before considering the facts of the case, the panel had sight of a letter **[PRIVATE]**. As this case is being considered in a meeting, the nature of it is in private; however, as there would be reference to matters of Mr Mulcahy's health, the panel decided to mark the entirety of the determination in private. This was made pursuant to Rule 19 of 'Nursing and Midwifery Council (Fitness to Practise) Rules 2004', as amended (the Rules).
